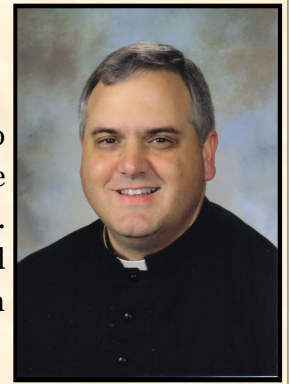

Dear Parishioners,

Please take the time this weekend to visit the many parish organizations who have tables at the Ministry fair, and sign up for at least one new ministry. Imagine the good things we can do if every one of YOU signed up for just one new ministry for you. Every one can have a part to play in the Catholic, Christian service we give to God and one another in the parish. Thanks to the Parish Council members and the organization representatives who are giving freely and generously of their time for all of us.

This week Father Francis and I will attend the annual diocesan priests' convocation, so we will be away from Tuesday to Thursday. Monsignor Calkins will be here for the 8:45 a.m. Masses on Wednesday and Thursday, and will be available for emergencies (so will I). We will NOT have the 6:00 Mass on Tuesday, nor the 6 a.m. on those two mornings for those of you who have already become faithful attendees to that early morning gathering. Friday's noon Mass will not be affected by the convocation, as we return Thursday evening.

As many of you know, there was an altercation between a parishioner and a guest before the 11: a.m. Mass on August 28, which involved the sheriff's office compiling a report. I addressed the issue before the 11 a.m. Mass on September 4, and said I believe a public apology is in order from both of the gentlemen who were involved, that they might be able to apologize, be forgiven, and we all move forward. While I have not heard from our guest who was here for a baptism, I have received a sincere note from our parishioner, who asked that I publish it here in my bulletin. His note follows:

September 6th, 2016: Dear Parishioners of St. Luke's Church,

On Sunday, August 28th, before the 11:00 A.M. mass there was an altercation in church that I was involved in. I wish to sincerely apologize to all that witnessed this uncalled for event and ask for your forgiveness if I offended anyone at that time. I would like to take this opportunity to also thank the men that assisted me with the injury to my eye. Please keep me in your prayers.

I met with the Comeauxs last Sunday, and I have accepted his apology. I think you as fellow parishioners, particularly if you were in church before that Mass, can offer a word of acceptance and forgiveness. We as a Catholic community are called to do this, I know, in the spirit of the Gospel and in the spirit of the jubilee year of mercy. So we move forward from here, and continue to pray for peace and harmony even within our own parish family, our church and nation.

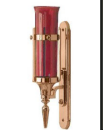

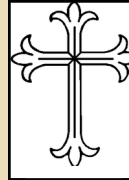

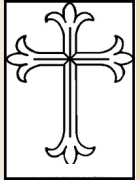
