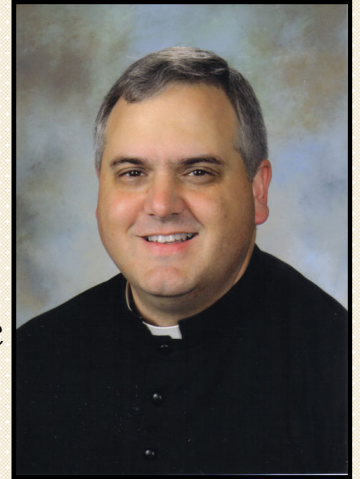

Dear Parishioners,

Like many of you, I have been at times positively disgusted by the candidates for president this year. I have been disgusted by their words and actions, their lies and crudeness on the stump and in the debates. Both major candidates are deeply flawed candidates. One vice presidential candidate shamelessly betrayed his Catholic faith to strenuously defend the infamous Roe v. Wade decision. Nonetheless, I have to vote. You and I do have the responsibility to have a well informed conscience about the candidates and their platforms, to bring our Catholic moral principles into the discernment on which major candidate, or which of the lesser known candidates, would be the least odious choice to make. How well do you know the party platforms, not only on the life issues--I think many of you know where the two major parties stand on that--but on the other important economic and social issues. What kind of Supreme Court justices do you want nominated to fill Justice Scalia's position, and others as they come open in the future? You and I need to make time to consider these issues. Our Catholic faith does put some burdens on our consciences as we head to the voting booth.



Above all, it is a time for prayer. We as individual voters need God's wisdom. This is why we've distributed prayers for voters before the election, and it is why we need to keep the life issue as the primary issue for our consideration when voting time comes on November 8 (or earlier if you choose to vote early). Pray for wisdom, but pray for peace in our country as well. Something is dreadfully wrong in the United States now, and most people are smart enough to recognize the situation even if they don't grasp the full causes of the situation. If Our Lady of the Rosary can help swing a military battle in favor of God's forces in 1571 at Lepanto, she can intercede to do the same now. So keep praying! God bless you and your families. Teach your children well. Live the faith in its fullness! Stay grounded in the sacraments, particularly confession and the Eucharist. God bless you all,

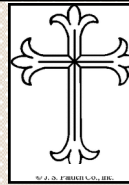

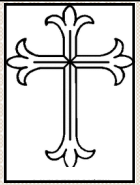
