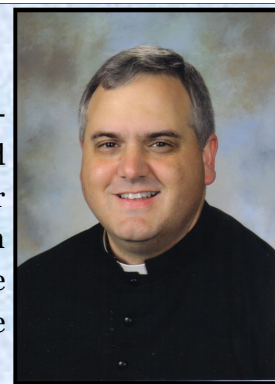

Dear Parishioners,

First off, I'd like to do a bit of a "public service announcement on behalf of Monsignor Calkins. As many of you know, he is a man of many books, with a prodigious and historic library. However, we need some space in the parochial vicar's office for Father Francis' books and effects. Msgr. Calkins is in need of someone who may have space in his or her home to store two six-foot high bookcases, with the books on them. If you are able to help him in this, please contact him directly at 504-655-7226. Thanks in advance for your help in this matter.



This week, it is time to announce to you what the votes were about the second daily Mass, and the decision I have made for our second daily Mass. I want to thank those of you who took the time and effort to let your thoughts on this matter be heard. There were 206 of you who filled out the Mass time surveys, which is probably a decent cross sampling of the parish. The individual Mass time that garnered the most votes was, not surprisingly, the 12:10 p.m. Mass, which got 62 votes for either first, second, or third preference, mostly first. However, as time groups, the second A.M. Mass choice gathered 58 votes, and the second P.M. Mass choice had the largest as a block, 86 votes. 6 p.m. was the second-most frequent choice. Therefore, I think it best to inaugurate a staggered schedule for the second daily Mass, that may actually reach all three of the time blocks most preferred by you. Beginning August 1, which is a Monday, here is what we will start for the second daily Mass. The Monday-Friday 8:45 a.m. Mass will continue as normal, so there will be no change there.

Mondays and Tuesdays-- second Mass will be at 6:00 p.m.

Wednesdays and Thursdays--second Mass will be at 6:00 a.m.

Fridays - - second Mass will be at 12:10 p.m. When First Fridays fall, the Latin Mass will continue, but at 12:10 instead of 12.

Why this schedule? Obviously, there was quite a desire for an early morning Mass for people who work in New Orleans (or Slidell for that matter) who would like to attend Mass before work. 6 a.m. twice a week should allow everyone who wants to come to Mass earlier in the morning. In the same vein, a 6 p.m. evening Mass allows people who work in the city enough time to fight traffic and get to Mass, as well as allowing our CCD students the opportunity for Masses during their school year, something we have not done in the past. I think this is very important from a teaching point of view, since many of our youngsters don't get to Sunday Mass frequently.

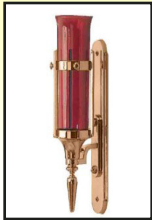
Many of you wanted the noontime Mass during lunch hour, for those who work in Slidell, so we are able to accommodate that desire, and still leave church available most mid-days for funerals. Since our church parish is one that still celebrates most of its funerals in Church (the norm for Church law, if not the normal practice in our Archdiocese), I want to preserve that proper practice as well. One final point is worth mentioning as well. As of now, with four priests who serve our parish, it is my intention to keep the 12:10 daily Mass during Lent. This could change in the future given the loss of one or both of the older priests who help us, but for now it will remain the same.

I know this staggered schedule will not please all of you, but I do think it is what best answers the request a numerical majority made in the survey. It will be on an experimental basis for the remainder of 2016, and then we will re-evaluate the effectiveness of the second Mass to see how best we can serve the needs of you, our parishioners.

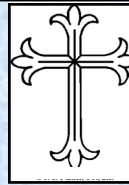

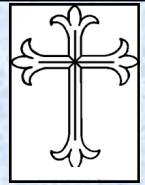
