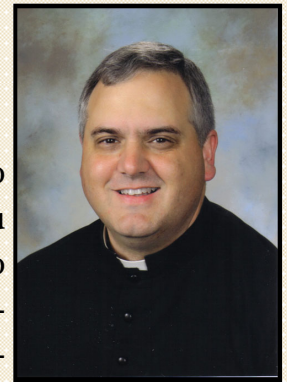

Dear Parishioners,

A word of great thanks is in order to you for responding so generously to the appeal for our Louisiana neighbors who flooded two weeks ago. So far, you have contributed over \$10,500 toward that effort. We sent the first check off to the Archbishop, who will divide that money evenly among the three affected dioceses (Baton Rouge, Lafayette, and Lake Charles). As further monetary contributions come in, we will forward them as well for direct assistance to parishes and families affected. In addition, the Good Samaritan Ministry has, at my direction, contributed \$1,400 toward the Autism Society of Greater New Orleans to assist their efforts in creating comfort care packages for autistic children whose homes were flooded out. That group is coordinating efforts for autistic victims around the state, so that will benefit at least 10 (at \$140 per person) victims in a practical way. Finally, the Good Samaritan Ministry twinned with St. Margaret Parish in Albany to underwrite \$1,000 of the expenses they incurred helping stranded motorists with food, lodging and shelter in the immediate moments of the flood along I-55 in Albany. So thanks to one and all for your long-standing support to the work of the Church, aiding those in times of great distress.

Those are only the monetary gifts that I mention there. Many more of you have given supplies, clothing, bedding/pillows, and I praise God for your spirit of willingness to help those truly in need. I know many of you suffered losses personally 11 years ago after Katrina, so I know you all know what it means to do and be without. May God continue to bless and strengthen you as you support the truly needy in our church and state. And in conclusion, I do want to thank those of you who have been the boots on the ground, those of you who have gone up to flood-ravaged areas to either gut houses or to provide meals for the workers doing the demolition work. This too has been a great service! I know those needs will continue for weeks to come, so please consider continuing to volunteer in those ways. We probably all know someone in the affected areas in need of our help. I have several people I personally know, so if you want to lend a physical hand in gutting and demolition work, please let me know and I'll put you in direct contact with them.

God bless you all, even as we remember the 11th anniversary of Hurricane Katrina this week.
