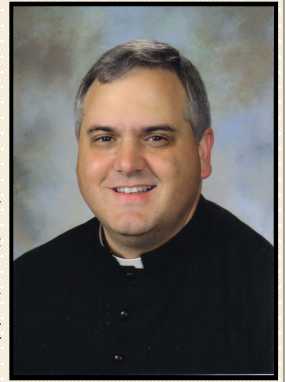

Dear Parishioners,

I'd like to highlight an act of generosity from the recent flooding that you probably don't know. As many of you do know, I go periodically to visit my house in Georgia, and I will attend and/or concelebrate Masses at Holy Family Parish in Lanett, Alabama, just over the Chattahoochee River from my house in West Point. I have become friends with the pastor there, Father Davis Koottala, and think he is doing a fine job shepherding the small parish family of 85 or so registered families there. Last week, Father Davis called me and asked how we were doing at St. Luke with the flooding. I told him that we had fared well this time, but that neighboring parishes to our west were badly damaged. He indicated that he and his parish wanted to do something to help. So I received in the mail a check from them for \$500 that we will give directly to flood victims for assistance. To Father Davis and to the Holy Family family, we say thank you for your generosity! That's no small amount from a tiny parish such as theirs, and we are grateful to you!

Congratulations to Scott Samford and the LUX Youth ministry a successful Cajun Fun Night on August 28th. There was a large crowd there, bigger than last year, a fun band for music and dancing and wonderful food. In addition, many businesses and parishioners donated items for a successful silent auction. There was leftover food, which I myself delivered on the 29th to two families I know who lost everything in the flooding. I also brought food to St. Alphonsus Church in Baton Rouge, which was damaged in the storm as well. It came at precisely the right moment for them, as they had had a cooking malfunction and burned trays of food they were giving out after Mass. God was truly in charge of this moment, because I happened—instrument of God, nothing more—to arrive at precisely the time they had begun to worry, "Where will we find food to replace that which was burned?". So I can tell you the Lord is working through you and me to help those around us. Keep up your generosity of monetary donations, yes, but I do want to challenge more of you to be physically involved with the people of our state in their cleanup efforts.

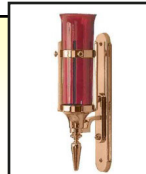

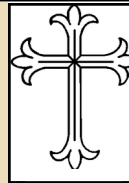

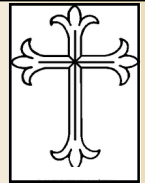
