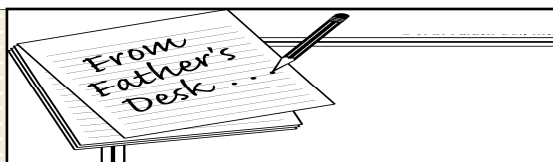

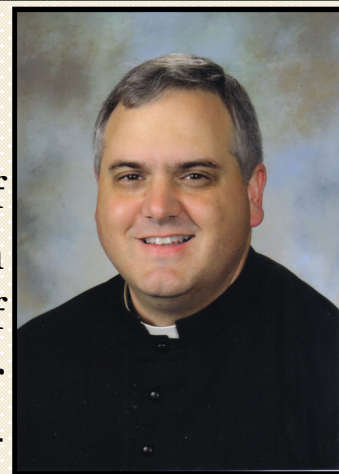
WEDDINGS: Call the office at least 6-8 months in advance.

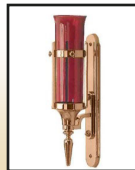

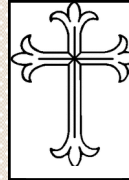

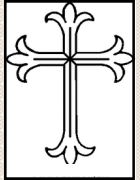
